He also led Third-Party Risk Management efforts, evaluating vendor security postures and negotiating risk mitigations on behalf of the organization.

Earlier in his career, Ryan spent 12 years with the United States Air Force. As an Information Assurance Manager, he handled cyber incidents for a 3,500-person unit and a fleet of 27 aircraft, managing vulnerability programs and system security. Before that, as a Software Developer, he spent nearly a decade building and maintaining applications using languages like C++, C#, and Java.
