Robert A. Graci \(Ret.\)](#) who joined the firm in 2019, Solodky adds to the depth of resources for the firm’s experienced attorneys handling receiverships and alternative resolutions.

Solodky received his J.D. from Duquesne University School of Law and a B.A. in Business Administration from Boston University. He is regularly invited to lecture on bankruptcy issues and is an annual guest speaker at the Lancaster Bar Association Bankruptcy Seminar.
